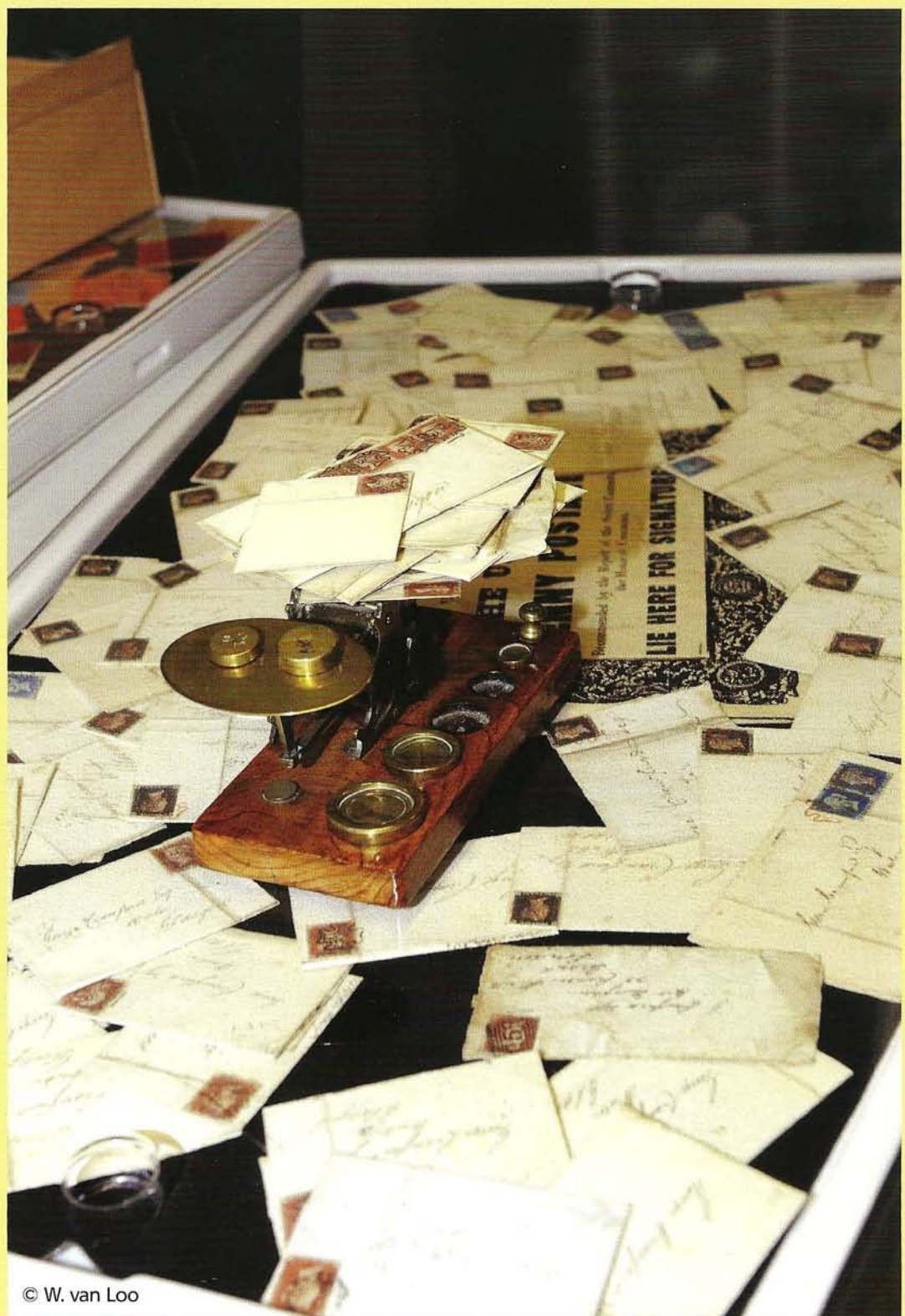

## NOTOS 2015 in Athens: International Philatelic Exhibition (12.–15. November 2015)


**Venue:**

Peristeri Exhibition Centre, Peristeri, Athens, Greece

**Visitors:**

Free entrance

**Size:**

800 16-page exhibition frames

**Participation:**

21 countries of the European South are invited with Commissioners' privileges. The rest of Europe and the World are welcome with exhibits related to the European South.

**Philatelic Literature participation is open with no restrictions whatsoever (1 copy only is required).**

**Countries invited:**

Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Egypt, France, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Israel, Italy, Malta, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovenia, Spain, Turkey and Greece

20 euro per frame or per Philatelic Literature entry

All FIP classes plus the experimental Open Philately plus "Classe des Champions" for distinguished exhibits

**International jury:**

FIP and FEPA accredited judges

## Entry form

The official Entry form is available online. Exhibitors wishing to participate in NOTOS 2015 are asked to visit the web page [hps.gr/notos2015/entry-form/](http://hps.gr/notos2015/entry-form/) and submit their entry form. Entry forms are accepted only if submitted on-line from within this webpage.

Please note:

- Entry forms are accepted only if submitted on-line from within this webpage.
- All applicable regulations including the Individual Regulations (IREX) applying to NOTOS 2015 are located at [hps.gr/notos2015/regulations/](http://hps.gr/notos2015/regulations/)
- Once submitted, a copy of the completed entry form is e-mailed back to the prospective exhibitor and the National Commissioner (where applicable).

Entry forms are accepted from:

- Exhibitors of the 21 invited NOTOS countries with any kind of exhibit.
- Exhibitors outside NOTOS with exhibits related to the European South.
- Philatelic Literature exhibitors worldwide with no restriction on the subject.

## Extract of the IREX

4.5. In Philatelic Literature Classes the exhibits must have been published/issued after:

- 1 January 2010 for handbooks or special studies (Class L1).
- 1 January 2013 for the remaining entries (Classes L2, L3, L4).

7.1. "NOTOS 2015" is a paperless exhibition, where traditional paperwork will give way to technology. No brochures, bulletins, catalogues, palmares results, etc. will be published on paper. Similarly, no entry forms, inventory sheets, etc. will be printed. Notable exceptions are the traditionally printed Exhibitor's Certificates.

7.2. All necessary information regarding "NOTOS 2015" is contained in the continuously updated and properly maintained website <http://www.hps.gr/notos2015>.

9.3. Deadline for submitting entry forms to the Organizing Committee is 31 March 2015.

11.6. Philatelic Literature exhibits must be received by the Organizing Committee until 30 October 2015. Not more than one copy of each exhibit is necessary. These exhibits will not be returned to the exhibitors. They will be donated to the philatelic library of the Hellenic Philatelic Society.
