### The Great Encounter of the Solferinos



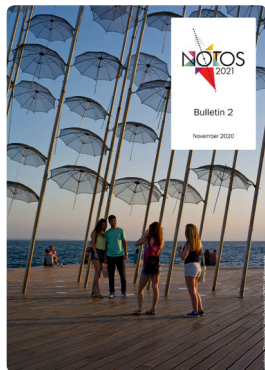
Another impressive addition to the Court of Honour: The famous Solferino, a colour variety of the 1871 40 lepta Large Hermes Head, undoubtedly the most elusive Greek stamp.

150 years after it was placed in circulation at the Piraeus post office, the NOTOS 2021 OC set an ambitious target: To bring the few surviving Solferinos together again under the same roof.

So far, eleven out of the thirteen known copies have confirmed their participation in NOTOS 2021.

### Athens welcomes the 2021 FEPA Congress

The NOTOS 2021 OC will have the pleasure and the honour to host the annual FEPA Congress for the second time after 2015. The upcoming event will take place in Athens on 23 November 2021, following the closure of the European exhibition.



It will be two years before the Federations' delegates and attendants have the opportunity to meet in person again, considering the cancellation of the 2020 Congress due to the pandemic.
