

A1. Following the Steps of Dionysus

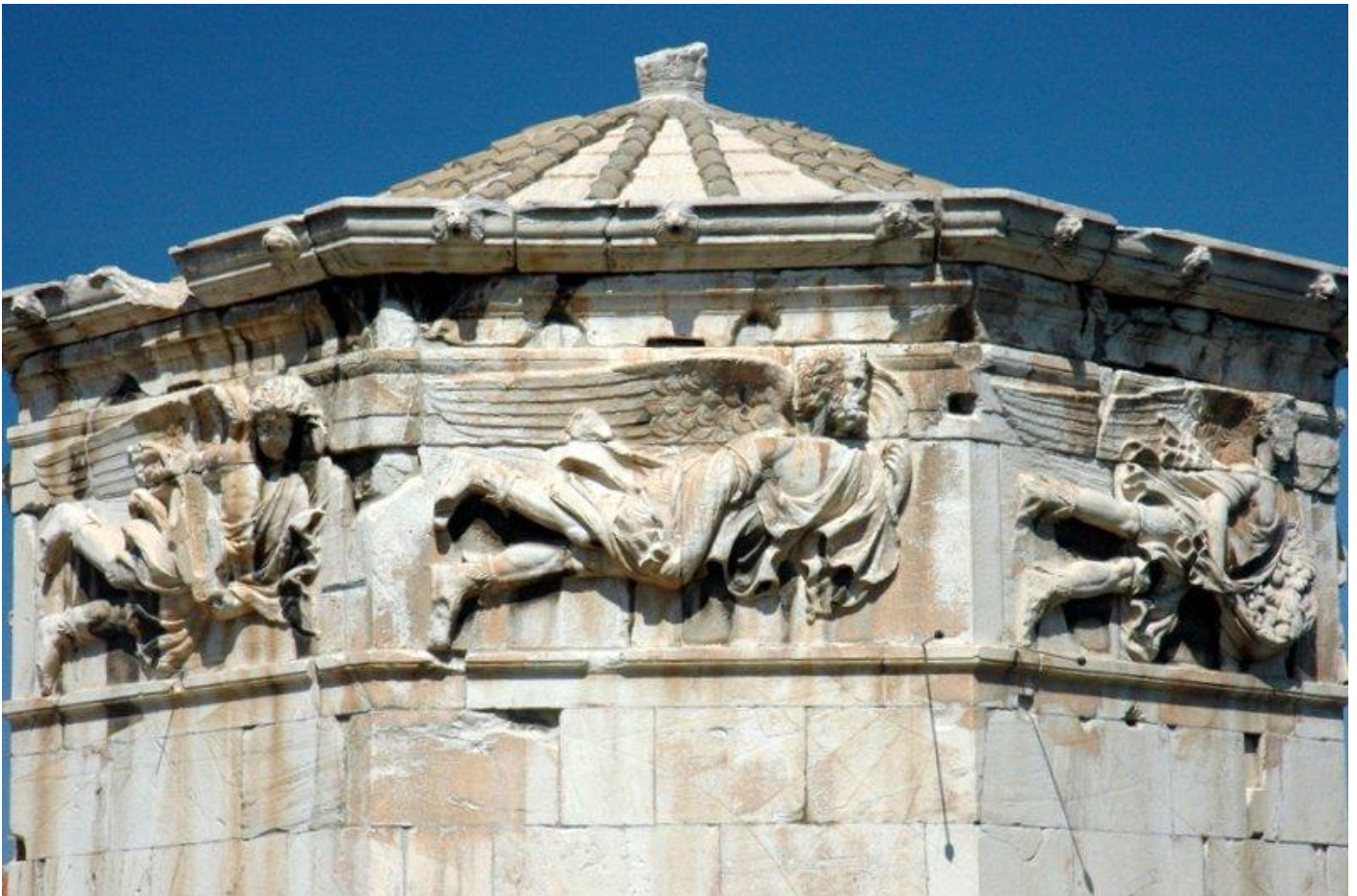

Walk Itinerary

Our Meeting point is in front of Zappeion Exhibition Centre (where NOTOS 2021) at 10.30am.

After a short walk we reach the Acropolis Museum in order to see the ancient artifacts related to god Dionysus and its worship by Athenians and have free time to stroll through the impressive Museum collection. Just across the Acropolis Museum we shall be looking at the 6th century BC Theatre of Dionysus and then round the corner the Monument of Lysicrates. The oldest Athens Wine Bar will be a first tasting stop of quality local wine, white or red is up to you.



Walking through the winding, narrow streets below the Acropolis brings memories of the Greek islands having a look at the Roman Market and the Winds Tower. Our proper wine tasting will take place at a nearby traditional tavern with Greek tidbits (mezze / tapas).



Time to visit the most interesting church of Athens centre where ancient sculptures were used for its construction, a remarkable fusion of antiquity and Christianity. An indulging street full of herbal and spice aromas is a photogenic place where modern Athens heart beats and where people are still enjoying a symposium with lively talk, food and wine paying homage to the Spirit of Dionysus!
