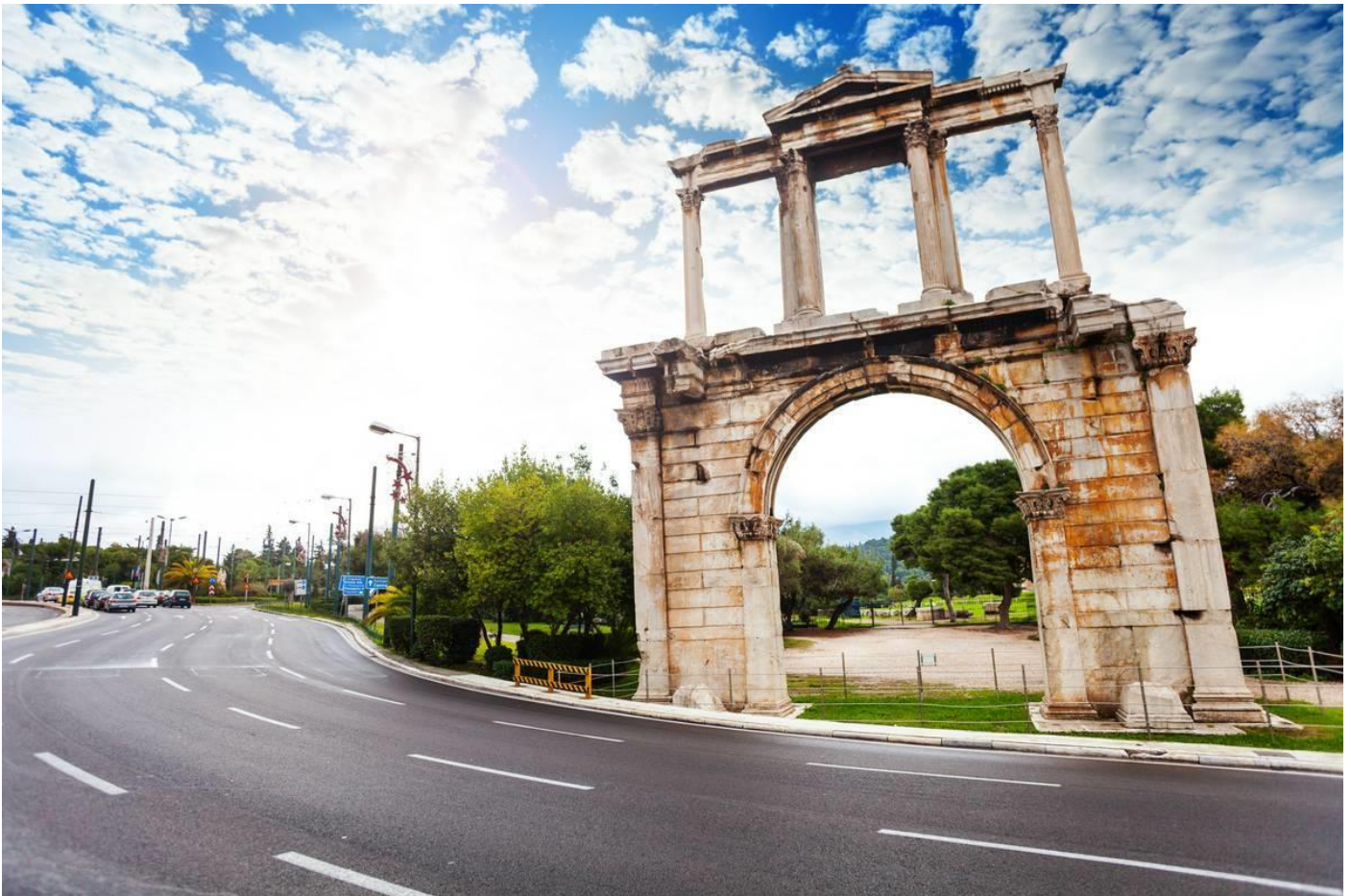

### **Walk Itinerary**

The Meeting point is in front of Zappeion @ 10.30 (Koulouri as Photo Prop). This walk shall combine a cultural walk and a hands-on outdoor photo session. Capturing an image of the Temple of Zeus and the pedestrian street leading to the Acropolis is a photo that every visitor to Athens has taken, very few of them are really interesting.



As we walk towards Athens oldest quarter we have the chance over coffee or a refreshment to explore, with the aid of our professional photographer, diverse photo approaches as photojournalism and close-ups. The Jewish quarter and the nearby neoclassic house where Henri Cartier-Bresson took his emblematic shot of the “double Karyatides” are on our way to the most exciting gentrified area of Athens where “two worlds meet”.



Coming to Psyri a former industrial quarter and nowadays one of the most lively downtown areas we shall be able to take fine shots of contrasting elements. Another photographically fascinating place is the Spice street and the Central Market on our way to the intriguing architecture centre of Athens, the neoclassic Athens Trilogy. Coming to Syntagma Square where the House of Parliament (Former Royal Palace) stands, we shall stop for a drink and a photo appreciation chat with some really useful tips from our photography expert on how to make your pics look impressive!
